The San Mateo County History Museum and Fuse Theatre present PechaKucha workshops for adults. The PechaKucha style of presentation uses 20 slides, each 20 seconds long. The presentations developed will be based on stories from the museums's exhibit, *Land of Opportunity: The Immigrant Experience in San Mateo County* and/or personal experiences.

On **April 9 from 1-4 p.m.**, participants in *PechaKucha and Beyond* will explore the creative process and generate ideas through a gallery tour. Participants will learn the basics of the PechaKucha presentation style, using PowerPoint to create presentations. They will work on their presentations and practice with coaching.
