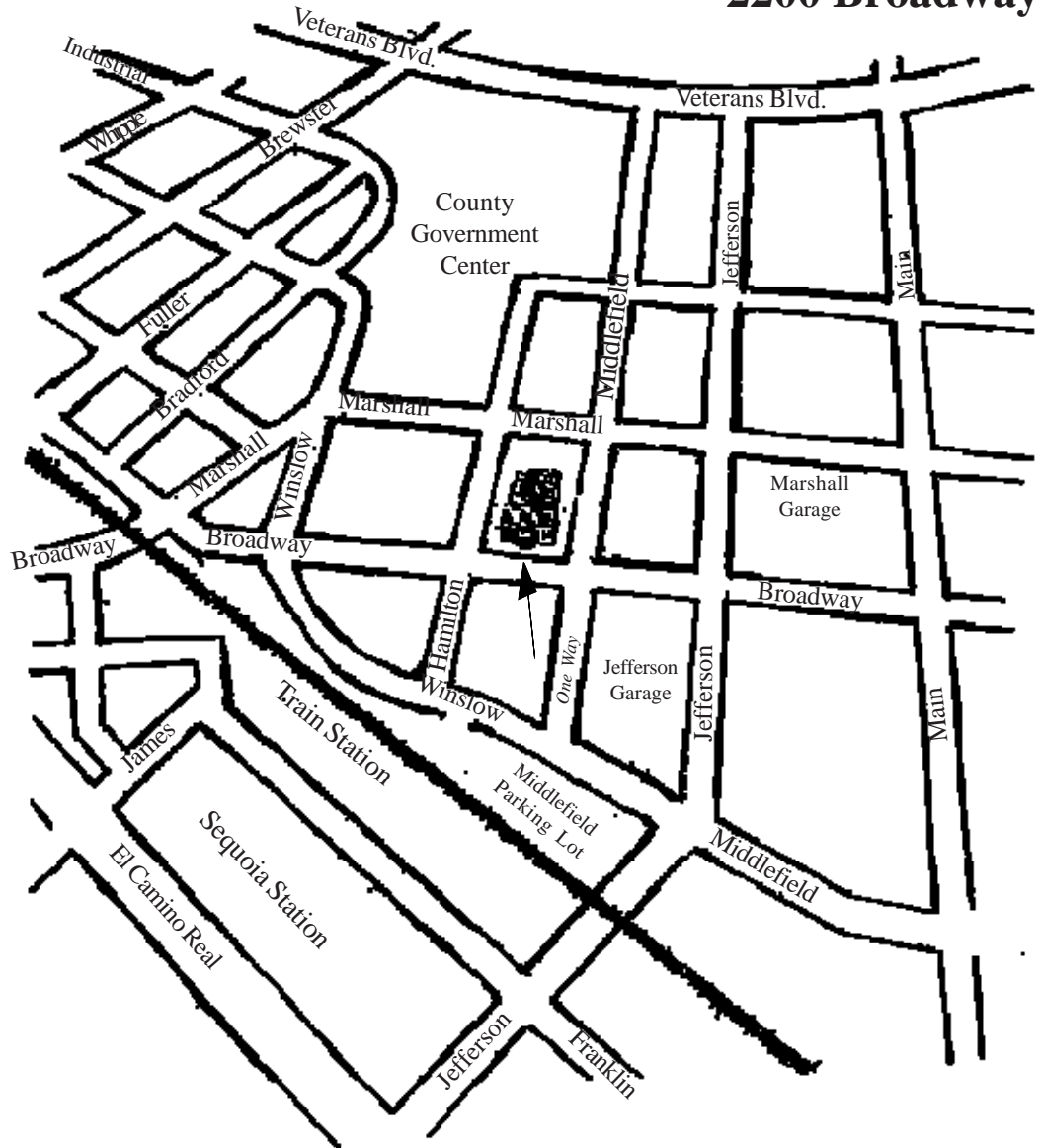

### Coming from San Jose:

#### Route 1:

Take **101 North**, exit Whipple Avenue.  
Turn left on to **Whipple Avenue**.  
Turn left on to **Veterans Boulevard**.  
Turn right on to **Middlefield Road**.  
Turn right on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 2:

Take **El Camino Real North**.  
Turn right on to **Jefferson Avenue**.  
Turn left on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 3:

Take **280 North**, exit **Farm Hill Boulevard**.  
Go forward on to **Jefferson Avenue**.  
Turn left on to **Broadway**.

### Coming from San Francisco:

#### Route 1:

Take **101 South**, exit Whipple Avenue.  
Go forward on to **Veterans Boulevard**.  
Turn right on to **Middlefield Road**.  
Turn right on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 2:

Take **El Camino Real South**.  
Turn left on to **Jefferson Avenue**.  
Turn left on to **Broadway**.

#### Route 3:

Take **280 South**, exit **Farm Hill Boulevard**.  
Turn left on to **Farm Hill Boulevard**.  
Go forward on to **Jefferson Avenue**.  
Turn left on to **Broadway**.
